Good morning, Senator
That Bill before Congress on AM Radio should include measures to improve Receiver quality, which would keep listeners on the Band.
It should also force to protect the Station Signals from interference from lights, etc., which the FCC is supposed to do, in their normal course of operation. They charge Broadcasters an annual fee based on population covered. However, the coverage that they charge for can be full of interference from LED and florescent lighting, computers, etc. All easily remediated if the FCC enforced their own Rules.
Also, some eight years ago, the FCC devised a list of changes that would help AM Radio in terms of Coverage, etc. It would appear that those meaningful changes have been all but abandoned. These issues should be included as well. Better coverage on AM would increase the Annual Fees that can be charged. I wouldn't mind paying this <i>if</i> I had a protected signal that had some more reach.
